Motion by R. E. Newton seconded by Ray Gravenstein that the policy with the Provident Life & Accident Ins Co, premium \$86.25 protectin 15 members of the Fire Company be renewed.
Motion was carried there being no dissenting voice.

There being approx. 300 feet of Fire Hose needed Mayor Clark appointed E. J. Brockway, J. L. Hesselhuus and R. E. Newton to purchase same.

On motion of R. E. Newton seconded by J. L. Hesselhuus Clerk D. M. Larson was authorized to draw an order on the Treasurer in favor of H. G. Taddiken for \$150.00 as advance pay on the drilling of the new City Well.

On motion of J. L. Hesselhuus seconded by R. E. Newton it was decided, by unanamous vote, that the amount of balance due Snyder Electric Co, \$5.46, be used to paint the electrollers and that the Snyder Bros Bond be returned, as the painting of the posts were part of their contract.
