The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 09-28-98 in Council Chambers. Members present were Robert Lutes, Steve Mugge, Ken Sanderson, Lloyd Weber and Kevyn Zacharias. Also present were Denise Hoy, and Gary Moler. Mayor Gearhart called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Gary Moler reported on the well house that is currently under construction. He also recommended that any time a curb stop on Wilhelm or Tucker Trail is dug up the fittings be replaced. Also, Gary will be asking Central Iowa Rural Water to work with Council on flow controls for Tenneco.


Motion by Lutes, seconded by Sanderson to set Monday, October 26th, 1998 at 7:00 p.m. for a public hearing and receipt of bids for the storm sewer project. The project consists of 3 phases including Duesenberg, the pool and the possible new sub-division north of Wilhelm and Blythe. Ayes 5.

Council discussed the new sewer plant and Gary Sindalar suggested that a bid date may be as soon as November 23, 1998. Council also discussed the easements to cross the Comet Trail to get to the new plant.

Sanderson moved and Mugge seconded to approve a liquor license and cigarette permit for Bogie's, which is under new ownership. Ayes 5.

With no further business, Council adjourned by a motion at 10:05 p.m.
