

July 23, 2001

The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 07/23/01 at the Conrad City Hall. In Mayor Sanderson absence Robert Lutes called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Answering roll call was Shauna Callaway, Robert Lutes, Bill Gearhart, Steve Mugge and Lloyd Weber. Also present was City Clerk Denise Hoy, Helen Kopsa, Bruce Marble and Gary Sindalar.

Council Member Mugge introduced and moved the adoption of resolution #120-7.01 approving executed contract and performance bonds for the Maple Avenue Pavement Improvements Project. The motion was seconded by Council Member Weber and passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Weber, Gearhart, Mugge, Callaway. Nays: none.

Discussion on Duesenberg Drive was tabled until August 13, 2001.

Council agreed to not participate in a voluntary watershed analysis study requested by the Grundy County NRCS conservationist.

Mugge motioned and Weber seconded to approve a liquor license for Bogies under the ownership of Jody Lynn Christensen. Ayes: 4. Nays: none.

Council set August 13, 2001 at 7:15 p.m. to hold a public hearing on the amendment of the 2002 Fiscal Year budget. The amendment would reflect the addition of the library and B-CERTs to the Cities budget.

Gearhart motioned, and Weber seconded to adopt resolution 121-7.01 authorizing the City Clerk to transfer funds as directed. Ayes: Weber, Gearhart, Mugge, Callaway. Nays: none.

Under other business, Mugge motioned and Weber seconded to allow Main Street to be blocked off from Center Street to Maple Avenue from 3:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Friday August 3, 2001 for the Classic Car Show requested by the Main Street promotion committee. Ayes: 4. Nays: none.

With no further business evident, meeting was adjourned in a motion at 7:55 p.m.
