ORDINANCE # 94

Councilman Rowlison introduced Ordinance # 94 . "An Ordinance providing for the issuance of \$48,000.00 of SEWER CONSTRUCTION BONDS, and levying a Tax to pay said bonds ."and moved that it be read by the Clerk. Councilman Bunn seconded the motion. The roll was called and the vote was -
