RESOLUTION ORDERING CONSTRUCTION OF PAVEMENT,  
NECESSARY STORM SEWERS AND CONCRETE SIDEWALKS,  
AND FIXING A DATE FOR HEARING THEREON AND FOR  
THE TAKING OF BIDS THEREFOR

WHEREAS, this Council deems it advisable and necessary to construct asphaltic pavement with a rolled stone base, with concrete curb and gutter, necessary storm sewers and concrete sidewalks on and along the following street in the Town of Conrad, Iowa, to-wit:

Main Street from the south side of Center Street to the north side of Grundy Avenue with inter- sections at Main Street and Center Street and Main Street and Grundy Avenue, said pavement to be 6<sup>6</sup> feet in width back to back of curbs and with new concrete sidewalks on both sides of Main Street between said intersections above set forth, together with necessary storm sewers and catch basins as shown on the plans now on file, and has caused to be prepared plans, specifications and form of contract, together with estimate of cost, which are now on file in the office of the Town Clerk of Conrad, Iowa, for public inspection for the construction of said improvements, and said plans, specifications and form of contract are deemed suitable for the making of said improvements; and

WHEREAS, before said plans, specifications and form of contract may be adopted, and contracts for the construction of the improvements entered into, it is necessary to hold a public hearing and to advertise for bids:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CONRAD, IOWA:

That this Council hereby determines that it is necessary and advisable to construct asphaltic pavement with rolled stone base with concrete curb and gutter, necessary storm sewers and concrete sidewalks, in the manner set forth in the plans, specifications and form of contract above referred to, the cost thereof to be paid out of the proceeds derived from the issuance and sale of Street Construction Bonds as authorized by Code Section 408.17, Code of Iowa, 1958, and from cash on hand in the amount of \$9,900.00 which has been deposited by abutting property owners for the purpose of being used in the construction of said improvements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a public hearing on said plans, specifications and form of contract be held in the Council Chambers in the Town Hall in Conrad, Iowa, at 7:30 o'clock P. M. on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of MAY, 1960, at which time this Council will consider the adoption of said plans, specifications and form of contract, and will consider any objections offered thereto or to the making of said improvements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that at the above time and place this Council receive bids for the construction of said improvements, and the Town Clerk is hereby instructed to give notice of said hearing and of the taking of bids, said notices to be published once each week for two successive weeks, the first publication to be not less than fifteen days from the date fixed for said hearing and letting.

PASSED AND APPROVED this 25<sup>th</sup> day of APRIL, 1960.
