Gary Moler reported:

- Was necessary to by-pass the sewer plant during the heavy rain.
- Masonry slurry will be put in where a culvert has washed out under Duesenberg Dr.
- Water tower will be inspected in July
- Have flushed the hydrants
- 2/3 finished on water line at City Shed

Randy Adelmund reported:

- Has been mowing grass and picking up limbs. The new mower works excellent.
- Have okayed sewer hook-up at Rick Morris' new home
- Has sprayed for mosquitoes
- Asked council's permission to purchase a small pull type sprayer to use to spray grass and weeds in the street cracks. The council asked him to check prices.

Mayor Gearhart reported that the ditch on the west side of Veldes' is half filled with mud. The county will dig the ditch out if the city will truck the dirt. It will need to be shaped when it is dry.

Chuck Averill was granted permission to fence a portion of the street off in front of Bogie and Bacall's on July 24 from 7:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m. for a street dance, in a motion by Krause, second by Schiebel. Carried.

Motion by Schiebel, second by Krause to approve a Class C beer permit and Sunday Sales permit for Center Street Mini-Mart. Carried.

Sanderson made the motion to approve a Class C liquor license for R.J.'s Lounge. Second by Schiebel. Carried.

Denny Hines reported that the Fire Department has obtained a '76 Dodge 4x4 pick up from the Forestry Service in Ames. This surplus equipment can be used but must be returned when the Fire Department no longer needs it. At the present time it will be used to haul equipment such as ladders and air packs. There was a motion by Sanderson, second by Krause to sign the agreement for use of the truck. Carried.

Hepatitis injections will be offered to two new members of the Fire Department. If they want the vaccine, more will have to be ordered.

At this time Mayor Gearhart closed the meeting to hold the 7:30 public hearing on the budget amendment.

There were no objections, either oral or written.
