Motion by Hurdle that the Petitioners for water on South Main to be notified for a meeting with the Council at 7:30P.M. at the Municipal Bldg. to expedite their request for water. Second by Beeghly. Carried.

Rob't. Slinker, Fire Chief, reported on the committees request for 8 pr. boots and 8 coats, for this year.

Meetings attended by Firemen \$8.00 per meeting per month, and \$ 12.00 per meeting for Fire Chief or assistant, effective April 1, 1970.

Motion by ~~McLean~~ that the request be granted and recommended that some Beeghly

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some firemen attend the fire schools. \$ 100.00 to be appropriated for this use. (Not to exceed \$ 100.00)

Mayor Martin called a Special meeting for 7:30 P.M. at the Municipal Bldg. to meet with residents from south Conrad concerning water extension.

Councilmen present: Beeghly, Hurdle, McLean, Metge.
Absent: Miller

Citizens present: Leon Mueterthies, Lucile Wood, Robert Payne, D.C. REECE, Mr. & Mrs. Curry Waugh, C.D. Wilson Jr.

After discussion of property valuation, tax revenue and fire protection a motion was made by Jess Hurdle Jr. to instruct the Engineers to prepare plans and specifications for bids for 6" water main across the creek then continue with a 6" or a 4" main to Oakwood Road. Second by Phil McLean. Carried.

Dale Clapsaddle represented the citizens in his area, asking that curb and gutter and street improvement to be considered in this years planning. The following block from Church to Vernon St. and Grundy and one block from Grundy to Center St. on Church St.

Motion by Metge to accept the application for a Liquor License for Jean Ferris at Jean's Tap. Second by McLean. Carried.

Motion by McLean that a 36' street on Grundy and a 38' street on Church to be included in the street improvement project. Second by Beeghly. Carried.

Motion by Metge to consider ^{and approve} the recommendations made by the Police Dep't. Second by Hurdle. Carried.

STREET LIGHTING RESOLUTION

COUNCILMAN MCLEAN introduced the resolution to install a new 175 w. street light on Oakwood Street going to the Golf Club House and move the south street light on South Main Street to the entrance of Oakwood Street. Councilman Beeghly second the motion to adopt.
