Dave Fox was asked about inspections on this project. He said the contract gave 45 days of the engineers time, so someone should be inspecting full time unless the work doesn't require it, such as hauling dirt and etc. A man will be at the site all the time during any storm sewer work, paving or anything that requires checking grades.

Fox stated Youngblut will use a paddle scraper and haul scarified material a load at a time where the city wants it. The council agreed the water line at the west end of Grundy needs to be identified and then the majority could be put there. If the material is in very small pieces a small amount will be stockpiled at the sewer plant. Fox reported there would be approximately 300 loads.
