Mayor Gearhart reported that the library has a broken panel of glass on the east side of the front door and he will get two bids to check the cost of replacement.

Kim Case, Randy Adelmund and Derek Ladehoff were then interviewed for the job of city maintenance person. Each was told a brief job description including street, water and sewer duties. After two and a half years he would be expected to have his water and sewer certification. It was noted the job included no insurance.

After some discussion the council agreed to offer the job to Randy Adelmund. If interested he would begin January 28, 1991 at a salary of \$8.00 per hour with a .50 raise July 1, 1991 if he was performing as expected. A job review Jan. 1, 1992 will result in another raise. There would be a .25 per hour raise after certified for water and the same when certified for sewer. He would be required to have those licenses in 2 1/2 years.

The clerk was asked to write letters to all applicants who applied for the job.
