

SPECIAL MEETING
AUGUST 23, 1982

The meeting was called to order at 12 noon by Mayor Daggett.
Council members present: Zern, King, Lutes, Gearhart & Graham
" " absent: None

Mayor Daggett stated that Gene Blythe had visited with him and informed him that he has possibly sold five lots on Wilhelm St. across from the Senior Citizens housing. The potential buyer is planning to build five houses and stated that he will have one completed within 30 days of starting the project if he purchases the lots.

Gene Blythe wanted the councils commitment that they would go ahead with their obligation on the lift station.

The council agreed to this and Mayor Daggett is to contact CGA to have them determine the size of pumps needed and to order them and the other equipment necessary.

Blythe stated he plans to put up a building in the commercially zoned area of the Blythe addition. The council felt he needed to contact the Board of Adjustment as he will need a variance.

There was a motion by Gearhart to extend the water line west on Lillian from Main to Wilhelm. Second by King. Carried.

Mayor Daggett will contact Bill Grabe of CGA as to the councils decision on this water line and also that the city expects an inspector to be in Conrad at all times while the street project is in progress.

It was decided to reside well house #4 and to place a dehumidifier in well house #1.

King and Gearhart were appointed to inspect the new well house.

Motion by Gearhart that the clerk pay Leo Rasmussen for construction of the new well house if it passes inspection. Second by Lutes. Carried.


Mayor Daggett asked that a special meeting be held on Thursday, August 26th at 7:00 P.M. to review the applications received for the city maintenance job.

Mayor Daggett will call and check an ad in the Iowa Municipalities Magazine of a Grade II waste water operator advertising for a job. If he is agreeable, an interview will be held with him on Monday, August 30th at 7:00 P.M.

Gearhart will contact Denny Metge and have him check the lift station on weekends when he checks the sewer plant.

The council was agreeable to install a light on well house #1, now while the wiring is being done, that will tell when the pump is on manual.

Motion to adjourn by Graham, second by Zern. Carried.
