The Council met as a Board of Review at the Council Chamber at 8 O'Clock A.M.. There being not a quorum present, adjournment was taken until 7:30 P.M.

The 7:30 Session Board of Review.

The Council was called to order by Mayor S.F.Price. Clerk John Morrow, Jr. being absent, the Honorable Mayor appointed E.M.Stark, Clerk pro tem.

The following councilmen answered to the roll call:
Levi G.Sherbon. John R.Gier. E.M.Stark.

Assessor Chas.Randall was present and he went over his assessor books with the Council.

During the examination of the Assessor's books Councilmen E.O.Ecklund and B.F.Wilhelm arrive at the Council Chamber.

On motion by E.O.Ecklund seconded by John R.Gier, which carried, \$300.00 monies and credits was stricken from the name of Wm.Thomas.

No other changes being deemed necessary, the Board of Review adjourned.

On motion by Levi.G.Sherbon seconded by B.F.Wilhelm that bills be paid and orders for same be drawn on the city treasurer. Carried.

Report of Sewer Committee on the hiring of an engineer was read by Chairman Ecklund and report was ordered placed on file. The report contained the information that Frank Steigerwalt had been hired as engineer for three months at \$160.00 per month to take W.G.White's place and had reported this day for work.

No other old business at hand, the old council adjourned.

The newly elected Council and Mayor convened immediately after the meeting of the old Council, this date, and all being present they took the oath of office.

As usual Mayor S.F.Price appointed E.M.Stark Clerk Protem.

First of all Mayor appointed all his committee with the same personalle as the last year.

Moved by Sherbon seconded by Ecklund that the Chairman of the Street and Alley Committee be authorized to purchase a new drag. Carried.

The Resignation of B.F.Wilhelm as Councilman was read and on motion by Ecklund seconded by Gier the resignation was accepted.

The Mayor appointed A.A.White marshall for the ensuing year at the same salary as the past year.

On motion by Gier seconded by Ecklund, A.A.White was elected Night Watch at the same salary for the ensuing year. Carried

On motion by Stark seconded by Ecklund that A.W.Poe be elected Street Commissioner for the coming year at the same salary. Carried.

Council adjourned until the call of the Mayor.

The Council met in Council Room at 8:00 P.M. at the call of Mayor Price.

Mayor appointed E.M.Stark clerk pro tem.

Following answered to roll call:

Mayor Price. Councilmen Gier, Sherbon, Ecklund and Stark.

On motion by Ecklund seconded by Gier that G.S.Beeman be elected Councilman to fill vacancy caused by the resignation of B.F.Wilhelm. Carried.

The following bills were read and on motion by Ecklund seconded by Sherbon were ordered paid.

G.U.Pritchard of Pittsburg Meter Co (Keystone Meter) being present, the question of purchase of meters was discussed and on motion by Gier seconded by Sherbon the following motion was passed: That the council purchase twenty-four 5/8 X 1/2 Keystone Water Meters with connections at \$11.75 each, freight allowed on 12 or more shipped at a time. Meters to have register in gallons and to be shipped as follows: 12 on June 1st 1918 and 12 on August 1st 1918, or before if ordered by the council.

After discussion of new water extension of private lines, the Council adjourned.
