The purpose of the meeting being in regard to set up a sewer rental of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, said rental to be used to maintain, ~~or~~ build or any emergency that might arise in the future.

Moved by Neuroth ~~seconded~~ ~~by~~ that the rule requiring an ordinance to be read on three different days be dispensed with. Bone seconded the motion.

On call of roll Councilmen Bone, Burch, Martin, Neuroth, and Strickler all voted Aye. Nays none.

Moved by Burch seconded by Strickler that ordinance # 68 an ordinance establishing the rules and regulations for the management, operation and financing of the municipal sewage treatment works of Conrad, Iowa. establishing sewer rental rates, and providing penalties for the violation of this ordinance, be passed and adopted as read by the clerk.

On call of roll, Councilmen Bone, Burch, Martin, Neuroth and Strickler all voted Aye, Nays none.

Councilman Bone introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption. Same was seconded by Councilman Martin.

"RESOLUTION "

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: By the Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Grundy County, Iowa as follows:

Section 1-

That the Council met in the council chambers in the Town Hall, on the 23rd, day of June 1952 at 7:30 P.M. at which time and place proceedings and action were taken in regard to sewer rentals for the Conrad Consolidated School, represented by Superintendent, Mr. Vern Miller, the Conrad Creamery, represented by Mr. D. O. Clinite and the Franzenburg Provision Company, represented by Mr. Paul Franzenburg Jr. said rentals to be \$ 6.00 per quarter, or four times the amount to be paid by residences and other business firms, which is \$1.50 per quarter and said rentals to be paid quarterly at the same time that the water bills are paid.

On call of roll, Councilmen Bone, Burch, Martin, Neuroth, and Strickler, all voted Aye. Nays none.

Mayor Clapsaddle then declared this Resolution duly passed and adopted this the 23rd. day of June, 1952. A.D.

At this time Mayor Clansaddle appointed Councilman H.E. Strickler as weed commissioner.
