Motion by Gallentine that the Mayor declare Oct 30 as Trick or Treat Nite. Carried.


Motion by King that Eng. Clapsaddle supervise the #4 well drilling, with Hoeg & Ames Co. Second by Gallentine. Carried.

J.D. Gould Chrm. of plan commission was present and presented the procedure for adoption of comprehensive plan.


1. plan commission passes (3) three resolutions adopting and recommending to the council:
 - a. THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN
 - b. THE ZONING ORDINANCE (includes zoning map)
 - c. The SUBDIVISION REGULATION
2. Council Adopts:
 - a. A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AS THE OFFICIAL TOWN PLAN OF CONRAD.
 - b. ORDINANCES, SUBDIVISION & ZONING.
3. COUNCIL APPOINTS:
 - a. (5) Five member Board of Adjustment.
 - b. Administrative Officer.

The plan commission recommends- on a motion by King, second by H. Gould that the council take a long hard look at their entire ordinance structure and make plans for future appropriations which will be needed to bring ordinances up to date. Carried.

Motion by Gallentine, second by Metge, to buy 1 uniform, 1 coverall 2 shirts for policeman. Carried.

Motion by Bunn, second by Gallentine to APPROVE THE 1967 IOWA STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION STREET BUDGET. Carried.
