ORDINANCE No. 99
A SUPPLEMENTAL ORDINANCE FOR ENTRANCES
AN ORDINANCE regarding

list of entrances properly available under terms of resolution signed January 20, 1965 for project No. FN-387 Road No. Iowa No. 185 of Conrad, Iowa.

WHEREAS, The above designated project has been completed and under terms of said resolution signed January 20, 1965 such completion and upon receipt from the Iowa State Highway Commission of a list of entrances provided for access under the above improvement specified as project No. FN-387 that said list would be

recorded under a supplemental ordinance, and

WHEREAS, Said list of entrances has now been furnished to the Town Council of the Town of Conrad, Iowa, by the Iowa State Highway Commission.

NOW THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Conrad, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. The compiled list furnished by the Iowa State Highway Commission of entrances provided for access under the above improvement specified as project No. FN-387 are hereby recorded as follows in this ordinance:

Section 2. That all prior ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
