Adelmund reported on a bid from Conrad Sales for a Woods mower. The mower is three bladed with a 7½ ft. cut for \$2650.

There was a motion by Sanderson to have Krause put the mower on order for delivery in the spring, second by Schiebel and carried.

Mayor Gearhart reported on the site for burning branches and limbs north of town. He reported someone is interested in purchasing that farm but even if it is sold the city will be able to lease three acres as a site for branches and limbs at a cost of \$50 per year. Don Kliebenstein is drawing the lease.

Disposal of leaves and yard waste was discussed. The city will purchase biodegradable bags from the City of Marshalltown at a cost of \$7.70 for 10 bags. These will be sold to residents at a cost of \$1.00 per bag and the resident can either take the bag to the composting site in Marshalltown himself at no cost or the City will pick the bags up at curbside every first and third Monday at a cost of \$2.00 per bag.

Trick or Treat night was set for Saturday October 31st from 6 to 8 p.m.

Kenny Sanderson will visit with JoeAnn Ennenga about paving the alley west of her property on Walnut Street. Cliff Wilson stated earlier that he wasn't interested in surfacing the alley because of the high cost.

Schiebel reported on attending a 911 meeting recently. The equipment for the system will be purchased by April of 1994.

Lutes and Sanderson will visit with a resident in regard to an assesment for a new street.

The purchase of several First Aid kits will be investigated by Mayor Gearhart.

King expressed appreciation to Bob Kruse for the new format of the report provided by the Sheriff's office each month.

Motion to adjourn by Sanderson, second by Schiebel. Carried.
