Ruth Crouse read the Dec. 1 Special Meeting of the Planning & Zoning Commission. The terms of Clarence Hogle, H.D. Carnes & Leon Muetherthies expire at the end of 1971. The Planning Commission recommends to the Town Council a new definition for "Prebuilt Structures" be added to the Zoning Ordinance, Article 2- Definition to read as follows:  
"A prebuilt Structure shall be defined as a structure transported to a location outside of a mobile home park and must be placed on a permanent foundation and must have a Uniform Building Code Certificate of approval. All requests for building permits for such structures are to be accompanied by a structural diagram of the exterior."

Councilman McLean Introduced ORDINANCE # 117 And Moved its Adoption. Councilman Beeghly second the motion to Adopt.



Motion by Metge to pass Ordinance #117 from the first to the third reading. Second by Beeghly.



That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.




