Mr. Johnson a representative of the Hawkeye Machinery Company met with the council as to a kettle for the purpose of heating asphalt for patching of the streets of the town.

After some discussion pro and con it was decided that a maintenance kettle be purchased, and on motion by Gould seconded by Radloff that the kettle be shipped at once from the Hawkeye Machinery Company in Des Moines at \$668.66.

On motion by Martin seconded by Burch that ~~an~~ recommendation from the street and alley committee as to size and amount of tile for drainage be accepted and that the clerk is hereby authorized to order same , providing that the property owner help with installing same. carried.
