NOTICE

ORDINANCE NO. 135
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONRAD, IOWA:

SECTION 1. COUNCILMEN.

The salary of each councilman shall be \$25.00 for each regular meeting of the council attended and \$17.50 for each special meeting of the council attended, effective January 1, 1980 (NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY). Prior to Jan. 1, 1980, the salary of each councilman shall be \$15.00 for each regular meeting of the council attended and \$10.00 for each special meeting of the council attended. Salaries of the councilmen shall be paid quarterly.

SECTION 2. MAYOR.

The salary of the Mayor shall be \$1,200.00 per annum, payable in quarterly installments, effective January 1, 1978 (NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-EIGHT).

SECTION 3. TREASURER.

The salary of the Treasurer shall be \$400.00 per annum, payable in quarterly installments, effective January 1, 1978 (NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT).

SECTION 4. REPEALER.

Ordinance Number 112 of the City of Conrad, Iowa, and all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
