The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 04/23/01 in the Council Chambers. Mayor Sanderson called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00 p.m. Answering roll call was Robert Lutes, Bill Gearhart, and Lloyd Weber. Shauna Callaway arrived at 7:10 p.m. Absent: Steve Mugge.

Council reviewed the budget amendment for fiscal year 2001. Lutes motioned and Weber seconded to set a public hearing on the amendment for May 14, 2001 at 7:15 P.M. Ayes 3.

Weber motioned and Lutes seconded to adopt resolution #106-4.01 " A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO PARTICIPATE IN A MENTORING PROGRAM WITH ANOTHER CITY". Ayes: Lutes, Gearhart, Weber. Nays: none.


Gearhart motioned and Lutes seconded to adopt resolution #107-4.01 " A RESOLUTION SETTING NO PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR THE CITY OF CONRAD, IOWA, ENFORCED BY CITY CODE OF ORDINANCE NO 69.01". Ayes: Lutes, Callaway, Gearhart, Weber.

Council authorized the City Clerk to serve notice on owners of vehicles, which could be classified as "junk" according to City Ordinance No. 51.01. Mayor Sanderson will provide a list of vehicles to the Clerk.

Lutes informed Council that Craig Smith has agreed to farm a small strip of land by the sewer plant. The land will be planted in corn with Smith incurring all up front expenses. Council will negotiate with Smith any payment due to the City after harvest.

With no further business, Weber moved to adjourn at 7:50 p.m., seconded by Lutes. Ayes 4.
