

Special Meeting
February 25, 1991

Council members present: Sanderson, Schiebel, King

Mayor Gearhart announced the purpose of the meeting was the law enforcement contract with Grundy County that had been reviewed by Don Kliebenstein.

The Mayor voiced several concerns. Namely the need to specify when the 210 hours in the contract would be worked and that the city would receive monthly reports from the sheriff's office.

After some discussion and reviewing a copy of Gladbrook's law enforcement contract it was agreed to get a copy of that contract to Don Kliebenstein and have him advise the council as to whether to include a section on liability in the contract.

There was a motion by King to accept the contract with some clarification as to Conrad's liability. Second by Schiebel. Carried.

Schiebel made a motion to sell the police car and related equipment to the Grundy County Sheriff's office for a price of \$6,675. Second by Sanderson. Carried.

Mayor Gearhart stated he had several complaints as to why the council did nothing in regard to the Park Board's overrun of their budget. It was agreed the overrun was because of repairs that needed to be done. The council wasn't aware of any problem until it was presented to them.

Also noted, was the Library Board's displeasure of not receiving their budget asking for next fiscal year, which was 25% over last year's asking. They received an increase of 7.50% and it was agreed they need to be more inovative in fund raising.

The council agreed to send Randy Adelmund to a school in Amana on March 25 and 26 to become a Certified Pool Operator. This would give Conrad a second operator and some of the classes offered would be useful in operating the city's water system also.

Mayor Gearhart stated the Park Board will have some guidelines for the operation of the pool worked up by next season.
