O. L. Brown, of the Central Fire Hose Co., bid 80¢ per ft on 2½" DJ Treated Hose with 6 yr guarantee.


Frank P. Clawson, of the Hewitt Rubber Corporation, bid 63¢ per foot on 2½" Underwriters DJ Treated Hose.


The General Fire Hose Co., of Detroit, bid direct 71¢ on 2½" Underwriters DJ Wax and Gum Treated Hose.

July 1, 1940.

Council met in regular session at the Town Hall, with Councilmen Brockway, Gravenstein, and Hesselhuus present. Absent: Councilmen Abbas and Crouse.

On being called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Mayor Gier, the minutes of the regular meeting held on June 4th, 1940, was read by the Clerk and approved as read.

Councilman Brockway introduced the following Resolution, and moved its adoption. Same was seconded by Councilman Hesselhuus.

RESOLUTION.

"BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF CONRAD, GRUNDY COUNTY, IOWA:

That the proposed assessments for oiling Washington Street from Center Street to Maple Avenue (2 blocks), Main Street from Lillian Avenue south to the C & N W Ry tracks (5 blocks), Church Street from Center Street to Lillian Avenue (3 blocks), Center Street from Church Street to Washington Street (2 blocks), Grundy Avenue from Washington Street to Dwight Street (2 blocks), Maple Avenue from Washington Street to Church Street (2 blocks), and Dwight Street from Grundy Avenue to Center Street (1 block) or 19 blocks in all, which has been prepared by the Clerk and is now on file in his office, notices of which in compliance with the state law, will be given all persons liable for such costs, be and the same is hereby levied against the property in accordance with the passage of this resolution, and all such assessments not paid within thirty days after the passage of this resolution shall be certified by the Clerk to the County Auditor as a Special Tax against the property."

On call of roll, Councilmen Brockway, Gravenstein and Hesselhuus all voted "Aye". Nays; None.

Absent: Councilmen Abbas and Crouse.

Mayor Gier then declared the Resolution adopted unanimously.
