Moved by Allen and second by Newton that we Concrat with the Iowa Road Building Co, for not less than 13000 nor more that 14000 Gallens of thier Road Oil at 7.77 cents per gal, applyed, Carried.

Moved by Wheeler and second by Canfield that we renew our Causilty Insurance, Carried.

Moved by Allen and second by Newton that the Clerk be authorized to write Warrant not to exceed \$600.00 for Fire Truck, Carried.
