AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE # 38 INTITLED ~~AN~~ ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND RECONSTRUCTION OF PLUMBING; ~~q~~ AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS."

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CONRAD; GRUNDY COUNTY; IOWA:

THAT SECTION 4 OF THE SAID ORDINANCE BE CHANGED FROM \$2.00 FOR INSPECTION FEE; AND \$2.00 FOR REINSPECTION; TO \$5.00 FOR EACH.

THAT SECTION 23 BE CONTINUED WITH: "THAT IS; ANY STREET, OR HIGHWAY THAT IS DISTHRBED OR EXCAVATED SHALL BE FILLED WITH SAND TO THE PROPERTY LINE, AND THE STREET MUST BE REPLACED IN LIKE CONDITION BEFORE SUCH EXCAVATION OR DISTURBANCE."

THAT SECTION 30 SHALL READ "ALL NEW OR REPLACEMENT SEWER OR WATER LINES SHALL CONFORM TO EXISTING CITY PROPERTY LINES AND IN NO INSTANCE SHALL THEY CUT ACROSS OR THROUGH ANY OTHER PROPERTY LINE IN FORM OF AN EASMENT OR ANY OTHER MANNER; EXCEPT BY SPECIAL PERMISSION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL AND INSPECTOR IN CHARGE."

THAT SECTION 31 SHALL READ "ALL NEW OR REPLACEMENT WATER LINES FROM THE MAIN TO CURB STOP MUST BE 3/4 INCH COPPER PIPE; Class K & "
