On motion by Gravenstein seconded by Martin that the Firemen's insurance with T.G. Russels and Sons be discontinued as recommended by the committee. Carried.

On motion by Gravenstein seconded by Martin that the sidewalk of H.D. Hunt's lot be placed near the fifty-five foot line. Carried.

On motion by Gravenstein seconded by Martin that Council adjourn. Carried.
