


March 20, 2000

The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 3/27/00 in Council Chambers. The meeting was called to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was said. Answering roll call was Shauna Callaway, Robert Lutes, Steve Mugge, Lisa Purvis, and Lloyd Weber.

Leon Yantis presented Council with a contract from Prism Fireworks & Pyrotechnics, Inc. for a firework display this year during Black Dirt Day's. Council discussed the contract, and noted that paragraph five indicates that in the event of an insurance claim by the Buyer, the applicable deductible will be paid by the Buyer. However, no deductible amount was listed. Weber motioned to enter into the contract with Prism Fireworks & Pyrotechnics as long as the insurance deductible on their insurance coverage is less than \$1000.00, second by Purvis. Ayes 5.

Weber moved to assess business's on Main Street 30% of the total expenses to replace the sidewalk in front of their business. The replacement will take place as part of the Street Lighting project. Mugge seconded. Ayes 5.

Motion by Purvis, second by Mugge to appoint Shane Tiernan, Rusty Schryver, Jerry Miller, Dan Erbes, Dorothy King, Gregg Sharp, Lloyd Weber and Kenny Sanderson to a task force to work with Iowa Codification on Conrad's Zoning Code. Ayes 5.

Motion by Purvis, second by Lutes to hire Midwest Asbestos, Inc. to remove the asbestos at the City owned property on 609 Main Street. The quote was for \$2,268.00, which includes removal and disposal of all asbestos material detected. Ayes 5.

Weber motioned and Callaway seconded to adjourn the meeting at 7:50 p.m.
