

Conrad City Council Proceedings

The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 03-22-99 at the Fire Department. Members present were Steve Mugge, Ken Sanderson, Kevyn Zacharias and Lloyd Weber. Also present was Denise Hoy, several Fire Fighters, and Helen Kopsa. Mayor Gearhart called the meeting to order at 6:10 p.m.

Council heard a presentation on a cascade air charging system that the Fire Department would like to purchase. The system would recharge portable air tanks, which the fire fighters wear at many fires. They currently travel to either Grundy Center or Marshalltown to recharge their tanks. The total cost of the unit including two large containment air tanks is \$11,097.00. Council made no decisions at this time.

Council then reconvened in council chambers at 7:00 p.m. Members present were Robert Lutes, Ken Sanderson, Steve Mugge, Kevyn Zacharias and Lloyd Weber. Representatives from the Park Board and CGA, and Gary Sindalar were also present.

Council member Lutes moved to enter into an engineering agreement with Clapsaddle-Garber for the Comet Trail extension, Sanderson seconded. Ayes: 5.

Council reviewed plans for the pool parking lot that Gary Sindalar presented. The proposed lot will be 27' wide with 20' of head in parking on both sides. Weber motioned to set a public hearing to accept plans and specification and for bid letting on April 12, 1999 at 7:30 p.m., Mugge seconded. Ayes: 5.

A public hearing was held on the financing for the new sewer treatment plant. No oral or written objections were heard. Lutes moved to adopt resolution #107-3.99 "A resolution authorizing and approving Loan and Disbursement Agreements and providing for the issuance and securing the payment of \$1,461,000 Sewer Revenue Bonds, Series 1999." Ayes: Lutes, Mugge, Sanderson, Zacharias and Weber. Nays: none.

Council then went into a public hearing on a zoning amendment. With no oral or written objections, Zacharias entertained a motion to have the first reading of ordinance #218 "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 103, BY CHANGING THE NORTH 72 FEET OF LOT THREE (3) OF BLYTHE'S ADDITION IN THE CITY OF CONRAD, GRUNDY COUNTY, IOWA FROM C-2 DISTRICT TO R-2 DISTRICT." Motion seconded by Weber. Ayes: Lutes, Mugge, Sanderson, Zacharias, Weber. Nays: none.

Zacharias then motioned to waive the next two readings and adopt ordinance #218, Mugge seconded and roll was as follows: Ayes - Lutes, Mugge, Sanderson, Zacharias, Weber. Ordinance #218, was passed and approved and will become effective upon publication as provided by law.

Council discussed the utilities going to the sewer plant, including water and electricity, among other special projects.

With no further business, Council adjourned at 9:12 p.m.
