

October 23, 2000

The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 10/23/00 at the High School Auditorium in Conrad. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Sanderson 7:00 p.m. Answering roll call was Shauna Callaway, Robert Lutes, Steve Mugge, Lisa Purvis, and Lloyd Weber. Also present was Doug Lutes, Gary Sindalar, and Helen Kopsa.

The meeting began with a public hearing on the resolution of necessity covering the Duesenberg Drive Paving Project. There were fifteen residents present including: John Ehn, Gary Heggen, Jon Gallentine, Ken & Carla Skramovsky, Gary Boyle, Doug Kruse, Paul Simms, Marg Bever, Jim McLeland, Jim & Diana Ward, and Mike Ryerson. After a question and answer time, the city Clerk reported she had received written objections from: James & Diana Ward, Ken & Carla Skramovsky, Marjorie Bever, Ann Velde, Gary T & Jean A. Boyle, Lynn & Krista Silver, and John & Jean Ehn. There was an oral objection by Doug Kruse. With no further objections or remonstrances, Mayor Sanderson announced the hearing closed at 8:30 p.m.

Mayor Sanderson then declared that a motion would be in order for adoption of the Resolution of Necessity and the new preliminary plat and schedule of assessments. Council Member Lutes moved and Council Member Mugge seconded that the Resolution of Necessity and new preliminary plat and schedule of assessments be adopted and known as Resolution #122-10.00. Roll call as follows: Ayes: Purvis, Callaway, Weber, Mugge, Lutes. Nays: none. The Mayor declared the said motion duly carried and Resolution #122-10.00 finally adopted.

Council Member Weber moved and Council Member Lutes seconded that the City Clerk be directed to file certified copies of the Resolution of Necessity and Preliminary Plat and Schedule of Assessments with the County Treasurer of Grundy County, and that resolution #123-10.00 be set out ordering the preparation of the detailed plans and specifications and the preparation of the notice of hearing and notice to bidders and form of contract covering the Duesenberg Drive Paving Project be adopted. Roll call as follows: Ayes: Purvis, Callaway, Weber, Mugge, Lutes. Nays: none. Mayor Sanderson declared the motion duly carried and resolution #123-10.00 adopted.

Mayor Sanderson updated Council on the Wolf Creek Estates II Addition and the Main Street Lighting Project. Council approved the city hauling city owned sand to Main Street to use as a base for the new sidewalk.

With no further business apparent, it was upon motion adjourned.
