Moved by Martin seconded by Bone that a fee of \$3.00 be charged for tapping water mains within the Incorporated Limits of the Town of Conrad and a fee of \$5.00 be charged to individuals outside of the Incorporated limits ~~for other towns.~~ carried

Moved by Bone seconded by Combs that the council adjourn. carried.
