
Mayor Martin called a Special Meeting at the Bank at 12:00 noon.


Mr. Mueterthies answered any questions concerning the present street construction.



Service are to contact the customers and collect a fee of \$ 3.50 per month for a minimum of 2 - 20 gal garbage cans to be delivered to the Grundy County Land Fill. Second by Hurdle. Carried.


Bob Vollbrecht, Marshalltown, Iowa was present to discuss and demonstrate a Radar Speed Meter. It was turned over to committee for final decision.
