RESOLUTION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF CONRAD, GRUNDY COUNTY, IOWA:

That Whereas Lucile Graves has made application to this Council for a beer permit authorizing her to sell beer on the following described premises, to-wit;-

Lot number ten of Block eleven of the Original Town of Conrad now the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Grundy County, Iowa,

And whereas she has paid to said town of Conrad the sum of one hundred dollars for such permit together with the sum of three dollars for the State fee,

And whereas it appears that the said Lucile Graves is a suitable person to whom to grant said permit;-

Therefore the Town Council hereby grants to the said Lucile Graves a permit to sell beer in conformity with law for a period ending June 30th, 1940, and the Clerk is instructed to send in the \$3.00 to the State and secure the formal permit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:

Whereas the said Lucile Graves has made application for a permit to sell cigarettes at the above location and has paid to the said Town of Conrad the sum of \$25.00 as the fee for the period beginning January 1st, 1940, and ending July 1st, 1940;

Therefore the Town council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad hereby grants unto the said Lucile Graves a permit and license to sell cigarettes for a term commencing January 1st, 1940, and ending July 1st, 1940.
