Moved by Hesselhuus and seconded by Abbas that Council grant I. A. Cohen Fireman's certificate for ten years' service on the Conrad Fire Department. Carried.

At this time the Clerk reported that during the past year the Council held twelve regular meetings and five special meetings, convened twice as a Board of Review, and twice as a Board of Health; that Councilman Brockway, Gravenstein, Hesselhuus were present at all regular meetings; that Councilman Brockway was present at all five special meetings, and Councilman Gravenstein was absent at only one special meeting, while Councilman Hesselhuus was absent at two special meetings; that Councilman Smith missed only one regular and one special meeting; that Councilman Abbas was present at all special meetings and absent at four regular meetings. Mayor Crouse missed only two regular meetings and was present at all five special meetings.

Motion by Hesselhuus seconded by Abbas that the old Council adjourn for the year 1941-42. Carried.

Immediately upon adjournment of the old Council the new Council met in regular session at the Town Hall. Mayor Crouse administered the oath of office to the new Mayor, Raymond A. Belz. Mayor Belz called meeting to order at 8:15 P. M. The following Councilmen were present: Berry, Brockway, Clinite, Gravenstein, Larson. Absent, None.

Mayor Belz administered the oath of office to each of the Councilmen. H. D. Hunt was re-elected Clerk by the Town Council for the ensuing two years, at the same salary.

F. A. Prescott was appointed Town Marshall and night-watchman for the ensuing two years. It was moved by Berry and seconded by Gravenstein that F. A. Prescott's salary be set at \$80.00 per month. Carried.

Mayor Belz by and with the approval of the Council appointed Dr. R. T. Spain Health Officer for the ensuing two years.

Mayor Belz by and with the approval of the Council appointed R. C. Dickover as Street Commissioner and water superintendent.

Motion by Larson seconded by Gravenstein that R. C. Dickover as Street Commissioner and Water Superintendent be paid a salary of \$100.00 per month, and that he give his full time to same. Carried.

Motion by Gravenstein seconded by Clinite that A. I. Miller be appointed Fire Chief of the Conrad Fire Department and that Bill Friend be his assistant for the ensuing year. Carried.

Motion by Gravenstein seconded by Larson that fire boys suggestion for two masks and 300 feet of hose be tabled until next meeting. Carried.

Motion by Gravenstein seconded by Brockway that Merchants Mutual Bonding Company's Bond for \$500.00 for Mayor Belz, as Mayor of the Town of Conrad, and their Bond # for \$2,000.00 for J. F. Wheeler as Treasurer of the Town of Conrad, and their Bond # for \$500.00 for H. D. Hunt as Town Clerk of the Town of Conrad, and the Fidelity and Casualty Company of New York's Bond # for \$500.00 for F. A. Prescott as Marshall of the Town of Conrad, all be approved and accepted by the Council. Carried.

Motion by Gravenstein seconded by Larson that the Clerk is hereby instructed to issue warrants for payment of bonds for Raymond A. Belz, Mayor, and J. F. Wheeler, Treasurer, in the amounts of \$4.00 and \$15.00 respectively. Carried.

Councilman Brockway introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption. Same was seconded by Councilman Clinite. Carried.

RESOLUTION NAMING DEPOSITORY OF
PUBLIC FUNDS

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Grundy County, Iowa:

That we do hereby designate the following named bank to be the depository of the town funds in amounts not to exceed the amount named opposite said designated depository and the Town Treasurer is hereby authorized to deposit the town funds in amounts not to exceed in the aggregate the amounts named for said bank as follows, to-wit:

First State Bank, Conrad, Iowa
Maximum Deposit under this Resolution: \$10,000.00
