RESOLUTION MAKING ASSESSMENTS

BE IT RESOLVED: by the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Iowa, that after full consideration of the schedule of assessments and the accompanying plat showing the assessments proposed to be made for the cost and expenses of constructing an 8 inch sanitary sewer commencing at the intersection of Alice and Center Streets in said town and running thence east along the center line Of said Center Street approximately 370 ft. to the center line of Lincoln Street, thence north on the center line of Lincoln Street approximately 430 ft. to the center line of Grundy Avenue, constructed of No.1 salt glazed vitrified clay sewer pipe with internal diameter of 8 inches, which said plat and schedule were filed in the office of the Town Clerk on the 14" day of January 1924. and of the filing of which notice has been published and posted, as required by law and the order of this Council, and after full consideration, appraisement and apportionment of this Council, and after full consideration, appraisement and apportionment of the special benefits conferred upon the respective lots and parcels of real estate shown and described in said plat and schedule, by the said improvement, this council finds that each and every such lot or parcel of real estate is specially benefited by the said improvement in the amount shown in said schedule, and that said amounts are in proportion to the special benefits conferrd upon the property by such improvement, and are not in excess of such benefits. and are not in excess of 25% of the actual value of each such lot or parcel of real estate shown in said schedule.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said schedule of assessments and the accompanying plat be and the same are hereby approved; and that there be and hereby is assessed and levied as a special tax and assessment against and upon each of the lots and parcels of real estate described in said schedule and the owner or owners there of liable to assessment for the cost and expenses of such improvement, the respective sums expressed in figures set opposite to each of the same on account of the cost and expenses of the construction of said improvement; and the said assessments aganst the said lots, parts of lots and parcels
