

Conrad, Iowa

May 18, 1951

The Town Council of the Town of Conrad, Iowa, met in special session pursuant to law and the rules of said Council, at the Town Hall in said town, at 7:00 o'clock P.M. The meeting was called to order by the Mayor, and the roll being called, there were present Ray Gravenstein Mayor, in the chair, and the following named Councilmen : Bone, Burch, Martin, Neuroth, Reece.

Absent None:

This being the time and place fixed in the published notices for instituting proceedings for the issuance of and consideration of proposals for the purchase of \$18,000.00 Street Improvement Bonds, and whereas no petition of protest objecting to said action or the issuance of said bonds has been filed, the Council proceeded accordingly to take bids at 7:30 P.M. The result of the bidding was incorporated in a resolution which was introduced and caused to be read in full by Councilman Bone, under the title of "Resolution providing for the Sale and Award of \$18,000.00 Street Improvement Bonds and Approving and Authorizing the Agreement of such Sale and Award".

Councilman Bone moved that said resolution be adopted; seconded by Councilman Martin. The Mayor put the question on ^{the} motion, and the roll being called, the following named Councilmen voted:

Aye: Bone, Burch, Martin, Neuroth, Reece.

Nays: None.

Where^{upon} the Mayor declared the said resolution adopted and signed his approval thereto.

The Council thereupon took up for consideration Ordinance # 67 entitled, "An Ordinance Providing for the Issuance of \$18,000.00 Street Improvement bonds and providing for the ~~XXXXXX~~ Levy of Taxes to pay the same", which was introduced by Councilman Burch and caused to be read in full.

Councilman Burch moved that the rule requiring ordinances to be read in full on three different days be suspended and that said ordinance be now placed on its final adoption; seconded by Councilman Neuroth.

Whereupon the Mayor put the question on the motion, and, the roll being called, the following named Councilmen voted:

Aye: Bone, Burch, Martin, Neuroth, Reece.

Nays: None.

Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion duly carried and said ordinance to have been placed upon its final passage and adoption.

Councilman Neuroth moved that said ordinance be adopted under suspension of the rules; seconded by Councilman Bone, and after due consideration thereof by the Council, the Mayor put the question on the motion for the adoption of said ordinance, and, the roll being called, the following named Councilmen voted:

Aye: Bone, Burch, Martin, Neuroth, Reece.

Nay: None.

Whereupon the Mayor declared said ordinance duly adopted and signed this approval thereto.
