

October 22, 2001

The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 10/22/01 at the Conrad City Hall. Answering roll call was Bill Gearhart, Robert Lutes, Steve Mugge and Lloyd Weber. Absent: Shauna Callaway. Mayor Sanderson called the meeting to order and began with the pledge of allegiance at 7:00 p.m.

Council discussed purchasing a blade for the tractor for snow removal purposes. Councilman Gearhart motioned to purchase from Midland Equipment a coupler quick for loader, a 108" dozer blade, and an 82" wide 1 yd loader bucket with quick latch for a total of \$6076.00. Weber seconded the motion. Ayes 4.

Council announced that they would be holding the December 10, 2001 council meeting at the Oak Estates Assisted Living dining room so that the Festival of Tree's could be held in Council Chambers. They also agreed that the December 24, 2001 council meeting would be canceled.

Gary Sindelar updated council on the Maple Avenue water project, the Maple Avenue paving project, and the Duesenberg Drive paving project.

Gary Moler asked council to consider purchasing a decanter float assembly for the SBR plant to have on hand in case the current one goes down. After discussion, council agreed not to purchase a spare one at this time.

With no further business evident, meeting was adjourned in a motion at 7:45 p.m.
