OFFICIAL NOTICE

OFFICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, AND ESTIMATE OF COST FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN SANITARY SEWER AND WATER MAIN EXTENSIONS IN THE CITY OF CONRAD, IOWA, AND THE EXTENSION OF SWS FOR SAID EXTENSIONS

Proposals will be received by the City Clerk of the City of Conrad, Iowa, in her office in said City, on the 22ND day of March, 1976, at 3:16 P.M., for the construction of sanitary sewer extensions and water main extensions as hereinafter described in general and as set forth in detail in the Plans and Specifications for said extensions, to be in the office of the City Clerk, Conrad, Iowa, on the day and hour specified or at such later time and place as may then be fixed. Also at said time and place, a hearing will be held on the proposed Plans, Specifications, Form of Contract and Estimate of Cost for said sanitary sewer extensions and water main extensions, and at said hearing any interested person may appear and file objection thereto.

Each proposal shall be made on a form furnished by the City and must be accompanied by a cashier's check drawn on an Iowa bank or a bank chartered under the laws of the United States or a bid bond and filed in an envelope separate from the one containing the proposal, sealed, and in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the amount of the proposal, made payable to the City Clerk, Conrad, Iowa, and said check may be cashed or the bid bond declared forfeited by the Clerk as liquidated damages in the event the successful bidder fails to enter into a contract within ten (10) days after award of contract and post bond satisfactory to the City insuring the faithful fulfillment of the contract and maintenance of said sanitary sewer and water main extensions as required by law and this

By virtue of statutory authority, a preference will be given to products and provisions produced within the State of Iowa, and to Iowa domestic labor.

Part A and Part B work under the proposed contract shall be commenced upon receipt of the "Notice to Proceed" issued after date of execution by the City. All work under Part B shall be completed on or before May 15, 1976. All work under Part A shall be completed on or before June 15, 1976.

The City Clerk's proposals for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date of Hearing and Letting.

Plans and Specifications governing the construction of the proposed sanitary sewer and water main extensions have been prepared by Clapsaddle-Garber Associates, Consulting Engineers, Marshalltown, Iowa; which plans and specifications and the proceedings of the City Council referring to and defining said sanitary sewer and water main extensions are hereby made a part of this Notice and the proposed contract to be executed in compliance therewith. Copies of said plans and specifications are now on file with the City Clerk in her office in Conrad, Iowa, for examination by bidders. Copies of said plans and specifications may be obtained from Clapsaddle-Garber Associates, P.O. Box 754, 707 North Third Avenue, Marshalltown, Iowa 50158, upon payment of \$20, all of which will be refunded to bona fide bidders; \$10 per set will be refunded to all others upon return of the documents in good order within fifteen (15) days after the letting.


