

Special Meeting
July 27, 1989

A special meeting was held at noon at the Country Inn, in regard to the color and lettering on the water tower.

Dorothy King reported that the color of the new tower now is a primary coat and the final coat will be darker. Also that the specs called for lettering Conrad twice on the tower. The tower is 132 feet around and it would take 29 feet with five foot high letters to letter Conrad once. Lettering it twice would leave 37 feet between the two words.

A decision was made to have Conrad printed on the east and west sides of the new water tower.

There was a motion by Sanderson authorizing a change order to make the lettering larger than the specifications called for. Second by Lutes. Motion carried with King casting the only no vote.

Also discussed was the clean up of sand from the sand blasting, and Clifford Zink's concern over the safety of eating his garden produce. It was the council's feeling that this was between Neumann Company Contractors, Inc. and Clifford Zink.

It was reported Sanderson is working at getting an itemized bill from Municipal Street Improvement and also having the company come back and check the street they repaired in front of the library as it isn't smooth.

Mayor Gearhart stated that the water line project being done by Hartwig will cost four or five thousand dollars more than expected because the ditch needs to be wider and the asphalt thicker than first thought.

The council agreed to adjourn to the water tower site to talk to the foreman about the placement of the lettering on the tower.

Motion to adjourn by Reece, second by Schiebel. Carried.
