

Conrad, Iowa. Aug. 6th, 1917.

The town council of the incorporated town of Conrad met in regular session in the directors room of the Conrad State Bank at 7:30 o'clock P.M.

Members present:- Mayor, S. F. Price

Councilmen- E. O. Ecklund, John R. Gier, L. G. Sherbon, E. M. Stark, and B. F. Wilhelm.

Absent - Clerk, J. R. Witzigman on his vacation.

Minutes of last regular meeting and special of July 7th, July 18th, July 23rd, and July 27th, were read and approved.

The following bills were presented and ordered paid as follows:

Out of the sewer fund E/O. Ecklund -\$3.72 ~~×~~ Out of the water fund E. J. Falkner \$2.00, ~~×~~ F. D. Strickler \$4.90, ~~×~~ A. W. Poe \$33.50 ~~×~~ Out of the incorporated fund for street commissioner. Out of the incorporated fund for marshall \$11.25, ~~×~~ Fredericksen 1.60 ~~×~~

Moved by E. O. Ecklund, seconded by L. G. Sherbon that the Mayor appoint a committee of one to confer with the Attorney Willoughby relative to bill of Edwards, Longley, Ransier and Smith and its payment. Carried. The Mayor appointed E. O. Ecklund to act as this committee.

On motion J. R. Gier seconded by L. G. Sherbon that the Clerk be authorized to issue warrant for \$500.00 out of the sewer fund to Aaron A. Coulter in lieu of deed covering the south 150 feet of lot 8 of County Auditors sub-division of the north east one fourth of section 31. Carried.

Moved by E. O. Ecklund seconded by L. G. Sherbon that the street and alley committee install a traffic sign at the intersection of Main and Center streets. Carried.

On motion by J. R. Gier seconded by L. G. Sherbon that the request for a street light near the Aaron A. Coulter place be referred to the light committee with power to act. Carried.

On motion by J. R. Gier seconded by L. G. Sherbon that the water district of the incorporated town of Conrad include the entire town except that portion of the north half of Section 31 lying south of the C. & N. W. Ry right of way. Carried.

On motion by E. O. Ecklund seconded by L. G. Sherbon that the light district of the incorporated town of Conrad include the entire town of Conrad. Carried.

On motion by E. M. Stark seconded by B. F. Wilhelm that the sewer district of the incorporated town of Conrad include that portion of the town that will be covered by the sewer benefit assessments. Carried.

The hour being very late the Council adjourned until 7:30 o'clock P.M. Tues. Aug. 7th, 1917.

For the Sewer Outlet and Purifying Plant Fund	----- 5 mills	----- 633.49
