Iowa, met in special session at 7:30 o'clock P. M., on the  
20th day of May, 19 52, upon the call of the Mayor,  
pursuant to a notice given to each member of the Town  
Council, which notice is on file with the Town Clerk  
and is a part of the records of said Town, and a copy  
of said notice is as follows:

Notice is hereby given that a special meeting of the  
Town Council of the Town of Conrad  
Iowa, will be held in the Council Chamber in said  
Town at 7:30 o'clock P. M., on the 20th day

a Resolution fixing and determining the rates and charges  
which the Iowa Electric Light and Power Company is en-  
titled to collect and receive as compensation for electric  
energy and service furnished the consumers of electric  
energy within the Town of Conrad, Iowa, and  
fixing and determining the rates which may be charged  
and collected within said Town, and  
providing the time when such rates and charges shall  
become effective, and the period of time that said rates  
shall continue in force and effect, and repealing all  
resolutions and proceedings in conflict therewith; and  
for the purpose of considering other matters which may  
lawfully come before the Council.

Councilman Martin offered the following Resolution, and moved that same be passed and adopted:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Iowa Electric Light and Power Company, acting under and pursuant to the terms of a franchise ordinance passed and adopted by the Town Council of Conrad, Iowa, and approved by the legal electors of said Town, is now and has been since the adoption of said ordinance, supplying, distributing and selling electric energy to said Town, and to the inhabitants thereof, and has been charging the consumers of electric energy the rates heretofore fixed and determined by the Town Council of the Town of Conrad, Iowa, and,

WHEREAS, for over ten years last past the wages of the Company's employees, fuel used in the generation of electricity, all material and supplies necessary for the generation and distribution of electric energy, and all taxes levied and assessed against the Company and its property, have greatly increased, and,

WHEREAS, during the said ten year period, the rates and charges for electric energy and service have not been increased, but the Company is now receiving the same rates and compensation as it did before the increased costs of its operations,

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of all of the matters recited above, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Town COUNCIL OF THE Town OF Conrad, IOWA, that the said Iowa Electric Light and Power Company be, and it is hereby authorized to charge and collect from the consumers of electric energy and service in the Town of Conrad, Iowa, at not to exceed the following rates and charges:

DOMESTIC ELECTRIC SERVICE RATE

AVAILABLE FOR ALL SINGLE PHASE, REGULAR  
DOMESTIC ELECTRIC SERVICE THROUGH ONE  
METER FOR ONE FAMILY WHERE NO INSTALLED  
MOTOR IS RATED IN EXCESS OF ONE (1)  
HORSEPOWER.

One dollar (\$1.00) for the first 14 kilowatt-hours or less used per month.

Five and 5/10 cents (5.5¢) per kilowatt-hour for the next 46 kilowatt-hours used per month.

Three and 5/10 cents (3.5¢) per kilowatt-hour for the next 60 kilowatt-hours used per month.

Two and 6/10 cents (2.6¢) per kilowatt-hour for all kilowatt-hours used per month in excess of the first 120 kilowatt-hours.

The minimum bill shall be one dollar (\$1.00) per month per meter installed.

COMMERCIAL ELECTRIC SERVICE RATE

AVAILABLE FOR ALL GENERAL ELECTRIC SERVICE  
OTHER THAN DOMESTIC SERVICE.

One dollar (\$1.00) for the first 14 kilowatt-hours or less used per month.

Five and 5/10 cents (5.5¢) per kilowatt-hour for the next 46 kilowatt-hours used per month.

Five cents (5.0¢) per kilowatt-hour for the next 90 kilowatt-hours used per month.

Four cents (4.0¢) per kilowatt-hour for the next 150 kilowatt-hours used per month.

Three cents (3.0¢) per kilowatt-hour for the next 300 kilowatt-hours used per month.

Two and 6/10 cents (2.6¢) per kilowatt-hour for all kilowatt-hours used per month in excess of the first 600 kilowatt-hours.

Minimum monthly bill for lighting only \$1.00.

Minimum monthly bill for lighting and power combined \$1.00, plus 50¢ per horsepower of connected power load.

Minimum monthly bill for power only, 50¢ per horsepower of connected power load, but not less than \$1.00.

The above rates are net. To avoid discrimination and to cover the extra costs of collecting delinquent bills, bills not paid within ten (10) days after rendition may be increased ten per cent (10%) on the first ten dollars (\$10.00), and two per cent (2%) on amounts in excess of the first ten dollars (\$10.00).

*Edison*

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Company is authorized to make contracts with consumers at other and different rates than the foregoing, provided all consumers desiring service under similar conditions shall have the privilege to make similar contracts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing rates and charges shall become effective beginning with all meter readings on and after June 10, 1952; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said rates and charges shall continue in full force and effect until further changed, modified or repealed by the Town Council of Conrad, Iowa, or such rate making body as may hereafter be established under the Laws of the State of Iowa, and given jurisdiction thereof; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions and proceedings of the Town Council of Conrad, Iowa, heretofore passed and adopted, fixing and determining rates and charges for electric energy and service are hereby repealed, set aside and held for naught.

The motion was seconded by Councilman Hewarth; the motion and Resolution were thereupon discussed.
