Council met at call of Mayor in the directors room of the Conrad State Bank at 8: P.M. with council men ALL present. Councilman Gier moved and Sherbon seconded that the following resolution be adopted:

Be it resolved by the council of the incorporated town of Conrad, Iowa, that the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized and empowered to sign the license presented and required by the C.&N.W. Ry. Co to cross their right of way with sewer outlet under bridge #93, and sign a warrant in the sum of \$5.00 to pay bill presented by said Company for drafting license.

Resolution carried, ALL councilmen voting Aye. Whereupon the Mayor declared said resolution adopted.

The Water Committee of the Conrad Town Council, hereby accept the work of furnishing and the laying the water mains as per contract with the Des Moines Bridge and Iron Co. under date of May 28, 1917. said work consisting of 3310 feet of four inch main an connections measured over all, and 720 feet of six inch main from the old main to the new water tower and 20 feet of six inch main laid in the old line said 20 feet of six inch main connecting the new line with the old line.
