Council met in regular session with the following members answering to roll call : Mayor, S. F. Price; Councilmen, E. O. Ecklund, Levi G. Sherbon, John R. Gier, E. M. Stark.

The Mayor administered the oath of office as councilman to G. A. Beaman as successor to B. F. Wilhelm, resigned. Mr. Beaman appointed to fill places on all committees hitherto filled by Mr. Wilhelm.

Moved by E. M. Stark, Levi Sherbon, second, that J. W. Beck be elected to fill the vacancy caused by resignation of John Morrow Jr. as City Clerk. J. W. Beck was sworn in as Town Clerk.

The following bills on motion of Ecklund, second by Stark were allowed and warrants ordered drawn: A. A. White, \$4.00; G. E. Shepard, \$3.25; Frank Steigerwalt, \$160.00; F. D. Strickler, \$12.54; A. W. Poe, \$59.35; John Morrow Jr., \$23.70; Standard Oil Co., \$ 16.96.

Moved by Ecklund, second by Sherbon that the report of the Treasurer for March and April be accepted, approved and placed on file.

Moved by Gier, second by Stark that matter of street commissioner be referred to Street and Alley Committee with power to act and report at next meeting.

Moved by Gier, second by Stark that the Mayor, G. E. Shepard and Fred Prescott be appointed a committee to locate the flag pole on one of the four corners at the intersection of Main and Center streets.

Moved by Ecklund, Sherbon second that the matter of salary of Marshall be left to finance committee to report at next meeting.

Moved by Gier, second by Stark to adjourn.

Council met in special session at Town Hall.

Moved by Stark, second by Ecklund that the motion locating flag pole passed at a former meeting be reconsidered. On roll call the vote was as follows, - Yes, Ecklund, Stark, Sherbon, Beaman. No, Gier,.

Moved by Stark, second by Ecklund that Council locate flag pole north of the intersection of Main and Center Streets as near manhole as Engineer Steigerwalt thinks safe. Roll Call, Yes, Sherbon, Stark, Ecklund. No, Gier, Beeman.

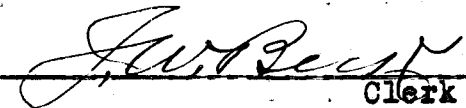

Moved by Gier, Sherbon second, that the Ordnance Com. prepare an ordinance on sewerage and plumbing and report not later than the July Meeting of the Council.

Moved by Gier second by Sherbon that the Treasurer report for the month of May 1918 be recieved and placed on file.
