Maximum Deposit under this Resolution: \$10,000.00

Councilman Clinite was appointed Weed Commissioner for the ensuing two years.

Motion by Brockway seconder by Berry that Fire Chief be instructed to turn over the money collected from the new members to the town Clerk, and deposited to its proper fund. Carried.

Motion by Gravenstein seconded by Clinite that the boys' scouts pick up the waste paper and they receive credit for same. Carried.

Motion by Brockway seconded by Larson that Mr. Gough have a no Parking sign painted on sidewalk in front of his place of business. Carried.

Motion by Gravenstien seconded by Berry that the finance committee be instructed not to exceed \$750. of buying Government Bonds. (Water Works fund) Carried.

Motion by Gravenstien seconded by Larson that Council adjourned. Carried.
