Mayor Gearhart called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. in the council chambers.

Don Kliebenstein was present to review and clarify the snow ordinance with the council.

He stated it was the city's option to either tow a vehicle or issue a ticket according to our City Code.

He stated our present ordinance was fully enforceable and constitutional.


Cliff Wilson asked Kliebenstein if all was in order for the closing on the two properties on January 3rd. Kliebenstein stated that the abstracts were not ready as yet.

Wilson also asked about burning the debris from the demolition of the houses in a pit outside of the city. Kliebenstein said the state law does not allow for this.

Wilson presented the third preliminary drawing of the new City Hall/Heritage Center. Several small changes were discussed and he will get that information to Sean Ervin.

King noted that Don McLean informed her there was a new sewer line off Church St. on the Gould property that was not being used. Also that he wanted to contact IE and have the power shut off and the meter taken out. It was suggested that he wait until the city has the water shut off.

Motion to adjourn by Sanderson. Second by Krause and carried unanimously.
