The bid of Banzhaf Roofing in Marshalltown was accepted to put a new surface on the roof of the library and city hall. Motion by Zern and second by Lutes to accept the bid of Banzhaf Roofing for \$1924.00 according to contract. Carried. Lutes will contact them for the council.

Several delinquent water accounts were discussed. Lutes will talk to one of the parties and the others are to be contacted and if payment isn't made by a specified time they will be turned over to the small claims court.

Dick Hibbs appeared before the council and asked if he needed the councils approval to partially fill in the ditch on the south side of his lot on Duesenberg Drive. The council agreed that this would create no problem.

Mayor Schleisman reported that he had received a letter from Leland Wiseman stating that he was resigning from the planning and zoning commission. The names of Herschel Carnes, Clete Neuroth, Burl Bone, Jerry Peterson, Ted Woolsley, and Dave Blackburn were brought up to fill this vacancy. Mayor Schleisman will contact them and see if any are willing to take the job.

It was reported by Lutes that the roofing job done by Banzhaf Roofing on the library and municipal building seems to be satisfactory. He reported that there may be a problem where the rain empties off the old fire station roof onto the library roof. Frier was asked to check this and devise the best way to direct this off the south end of the building.

Willard Dielschneider representing the Telephone Action Committee appeared before the council and reported that because of numerous reports of problems existing within the telephone system this committee has been reactivated. He stated that the committee would appreciate the backing of the city council and also business concerns in Conrad and Beaman and possibly Gladbrook and Garwin.

Bill Gearhart was asked to check on the bill from Schiebel Electric to Smeal Fire Equipment Co. and see that it is taken care of.

It was agreed by the council to raise Frier's salary to \$13,000.00 annually beginning August 15, 1980.

The council also agreed to pay Bob Kruse for two weeks of vacation that he will not use. This will be paid in a separate check at the end of August with his regular monthly salary.

Beeghly will call Mr. McVey at Iowa Electric Light and Power in regard to paying for the repair of the alley between Main and Washington by the new bank building, where their equipment left several large holes.

The clerk was asked to telephone Minnesota Valley Testing Laboratories, Inc. at Nevada to inquire if they offered services similar to SERCO.

Sheriff Bill Marten discussed the possibilities of a new squad car for Conrad with the Council. Zern, Moler and Beeghly will check the car lots and see what is available.

The report from SERCO dated July 1980 was submitted and filed.
