The Town Council met in Special Session at the Municipal Bldg. at 8:00 P. M. with the following members present. Daggett, Koehler, Simms, Martin, Combs. Absent: Mayor Friday and Clerk Bunn.

Councilman Combs having been duly appointed as Mayor Pro-Tem at the first meeting of the new council by Mayor Friday, took the chair of Mayor and appointed councilman Martin to act as Clerk Pro-Tem.

Motion by Simms that Hartgrave Construction Co. be contacted to send representative to meet with the council relative to street work. Seconded by Koehler. Carried.

Wm. Glass met with the council in regard to laying new 4" water main from the new well to present mains. Mr. Glass bid for this work was 40¢ per foot for digging and filling and 22¢ per foot for laying the pipe. Lewis Whitney of Cedar Rapids also made a bid on this work at 40¢ per foot for digging and filling and 22¢ per foot for laying the pipe.
