Also to accept his <sup>putter</sup> proposition on crossings, at 80¢ per hour for self And not exceed 50¢ per hour for helper. Carried.

Mooved by Frederick and second by Gier that the mayor appoint the Clerk to see Mr Hurlbutt as to a propostion granting him permission To putting his walk not exceed four feet south of his south line So as to conform with the Alexander walk. and it is to be put in As soon as Alexanders is completed. Carried.
