

April 22, 2002

The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 04/22/02 at the Conrad City Hall. Answering roll call was Shauna Callaway, Bill Gearhart, Robert Lutes, LeAnn Lynch, and Steve Mugge. Mayor Sanderson called the meeting to order and began with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00 p.m.

Council discussed insurance coverage for the City of Conrad. Kaci, representing Iowa Communities Insurance Pool (ICAP), and agent Bob Klein were present to answer any questions. After discussion and price comparison, Lutes motioned and Lynch seconded to switch the Cities insurance from EMC to ICAP. Ayes: 5. Nays: none.

After discussion Lutes motioned and Mugge seconded allow property owners on Duesenberg Drive and East Maple Avenue a credit for the difference between ~~June~~^{July} 2001 water and sewer bill and the June ~~2002~~^{July} water and sewer bill, so that they could water the new seed planted due to construction of the new curb and gutter. 
City Clerk reported that utility easements were being clarified for Wolf Creek Estates II Addition. Alliant Energy will soon be installing electric and gas services to the lots.

Council discussed several items with Engineer Gary Sindelar, including the black top surface on Duesenberg Drive and a couple of cracks in the concrete on Maple Avenue. Council asked Sindelar to speak to the contractors to resolve the issues. They also discussed some possible options for storm water drainage that comes from the parking lot at the High School. Sindelar will be drawing up plans for future action.

Mayor Sanderson then proclaimed the week of May 12-18, 2002 as Iowa School Board Recognition Week. They urge all citizens to join them in recognizing the dedication and hard work of the BCLUW School Board Members in preparing today's students for tomorrow's world.
