Immediately after the old council adjourned, Mayor Clapsaddle called the new council together, with the following members present.

Bone, Combs, Martin, Schultz, and Strickler. Absent None.

Mayor Clapsaddle gave the oath of office to the two new members, Bert O. Combs and Will F. Schultz.

Moved by Bone seconded by Strickler that the meeting place for the Town Council should be at the Town Hall on the first Monday of each month and the time 7:30 P.M. carried

Moved by Martin seconded by Bone that H.D. Hunt be re-hired as town clerk for the two year term, starting January 4, 1954 and ending at the first meeting of January 1956. carried
Salary to be \$200.00 Two Hundred Dollars per quarter. carried

Mayor Clapsaddle by and with approval of the Council appointed Al Johnson as town marshall for two months. His salary to be \$225.00 Two Hundred Twenty-five per month.

Mayor Clapsaddle by and with approval of the Council appointed R.C. Dickover as street commissioner and water superentendant. His salary to be \$235.00 Two Hundred Thirty-five per month.

One hundred and forty-five dollars from the street fund and "inty dollars from the utilities fund.

Mayor Clapsaddle by and with the approval of the Council appointed Dr. E.L. Jacobs as Health Officer and the fee to be \$20.00 Twenty dollars per year.

RESOLUTION NAMING DEPOSITORY OF
PUBLIC FUNDS:

That we do hereby designate the following named bank to be the depository of the town funds in amounts not to exceed the amount named opposite said designated depository and the Town Treasurer is hereby authorized to deposit the town funds in amounts not to exceed in the aggregate the amounts named for said bank as follows, to-wit:

FIRST STATE BANK, Conrad, Iowa:
Maximum Deposit under this Resolution; \$30,000.00
Thirty Thousand Dollars.
