Discussion of traffic conditions in the Town of Conrad brought about the following change in Ordinance # 43.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Conrad, Iowa: that the contents of Section 10 of Ordinance #43 be stricken and replaced with the following which will constitute careless driving:

1. Failure to observe speed limits of the Town of Conrad and the State Code.
2. Failure to turn on lights when driving after sundown.
3. Endangering the life or property of any person.
4. Unnecessary sudden starts or stops.
5. Destroying old or newly constructed streets.
6. Running over flares.
7. Driving on or destroying city property which includes parks, parking or any other city property other than streets.
8. Turning corners too fast.
9. Failure to observe signs or policeman on duty.
10. Excessive noise or faulty equipment.
11. Improper parking.
12. Improper passing
13. Failure to yield right of way.

Moved by Curry, seconded by Wilson to adopt new change in Ordinance #43 as stated. Carried.

Motion by Koehler, seconded by Wilson for adjournment. Carried.
