The regular monthly session of the Town Council, was called to order by Mayor ~~of~~ S.F. Price and the following councilmen answered to the roll call.

Mayor Price appointed E.O. Ecklund Clerk pro tem.

An amendment to motion regarding the shutting off street lights was offered: said motion to include the following addition.

In accordance with the order of the fuel administrator.  
Motion carried.

Minutes of last meeting read and approved as corrected.

The treasurers statement for Feb'y. was presented.

Motion made by Gier and second by Shrrbon that report be approved and placed on file. Motion carried.

Resignation of John Morrow Jr. as town clerk was presented and ~~put~~ placed on file.

The order of Cole Bros. Date Feb'y. 4, 1918, directing the payment ~~of~~ ax of all moneys due or become due Cole Bros. be paid to the Central Trust Co. of Des Moines was read. And on motion of Ecklund ~~was~~ second by Stark that order be accepted and attached to the contract of Cole Bros. Motion carried.

The following bills were presented.

Water Fund. and on motion of Sherbon second by Wilhelm that bills be allowed and orders drawn on Tresr. for same. Carried.

Motion by J.R. Gier and Sec. by Sherbon that the Clerk be instructed to pay G.C. Hurlbutt \$20.00 for payment due Jan'y. 1. 1918. as per contract on sewer outlet. Motion carried.

Gier moved and Ecklund second that bills of J. O'Connor <sup>\$3.00</sup> and E. Knight \$2.80. be laid on table. Carried.

Motion made by Sherbon and second by Wilhelm that the street lights be ordered on account of public safety and that prior order of turning off lights be revoked. motion carried.

Motion to adjourn until Monday Mch. 11. 1918. <sup>7:30 PM.</sup> Carried.

Mayor S.F. Price appointed Clerk pro tem. E.M. Stark.

Minutes of March 4, 1918, were read and approved.

On motion of J.R. Gier second by L.G. Sherbon, that matter of hiring an engineer to take W.G. White's place was ~~not~~ placed was placed in hands of sewer committee with power to act, Carried.

Bills of account were read: L.G. Morrison \$3.59

Moved by Ecklund second by Sherbon that bills be paid and order drawn on treasurer for same. Carried.

Moved by Ecklund second by Stark that the Mayor appoint three Judges and two Clerks to serve at election to be held March, 25<sup>th</sup>/1918. Carried.

The Mayor appointed as Clerks, John Morrow Jr. and E.O. Ecklund. As Judges B.F.Wilhelm, L.G.Sherbon, E.M.Stark.

Councilman J.R.Gier offered Ordinance No. 55.being an Ordinance to prevent the erection,substantial alteration,partial rebuilding, or moving buildings within certain limits of the Town of Conrad,Iowa, unless the same be constructed of fire-proof materials.

Councilman J.R.Gier moved that the rule requiring said Ordinance to be read on three different days be dispensed with and suspended and that said Ordinance No.55, be passed to its third reading. Motion was seconded by Councilman L.G.Sherbon.

The motion was put to a vote and declared carried unanimously. Ordinance No.55, was then given its third reading.

Councilman J.R.Gier then moved that Ordinance No.55, be adopted. Motion was second by Councilman L.G.Sherbon.

The roll was ordered called resulting as follows.

Ayes,Councilman L.G.Sherbon, J.R.Gier, E.O.Ecklund,E.M.Stark. Nays,None. Absent or not voting B.F.Wilhelm.

The Ordinance No.55, was declared adopted, and is as follows.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the Town of Conrad,Iowa:-

Section.1. That hereafter no building,or addition to any building, shall be built,erected or moved on to; Lots One to Fifteen inclusive,in Block Eleven (11),and Six to Twenty inclusive in Block Ten, (10) in the original Town of Conrad; all of Block Three,(3) and Lots Six (6) to Eighteen (18) inclusive,in Block Two, (2)in the original Town of Conrad Grove, now the Incorporated Town of Conrad.

Nor shall any substantial alteration be made in any such building involving partial rebuilding,unless the outer ~~thru~~walls walls thereof shall be made of brick and mortar,tile and mortar,stone and mortar,iron or concrete and the roof thereof be covered with fire-proof material;but if such outer walls ~~be~~ are of iron construction such iron walls must be self supporting and if of brick,tile,stone or concrete must be at least six inches thick.

2. If any person,persons,partnership or corporation shall erect or attempt to erect or move or attempt to move any building or part thereof or any addition to any building contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance it shall be the duty of the Town Marshall to remove the same forthwith and he is authorized and empowered to summon sufficient assistance for the purpose.

3. The Marshall shall be entitled to the same fees for services performed under this Ordinance as for like services in any othercase,which may be collected by civil suit against the person or persons,partnership or corporation violating the first section of this ordinance,together with all other expenses and costs incurred in removing any building or addition thereto erected or attempted to be erected,moved or attempted to be moved contrary to this Ordinance.

4. No building ~~be~~ <sup>shall</sup> be erected,added to ,altered,enlarged,or moved onto that portion of the town of Conrad referred to in section 1 hereof without first obtaining a permit therefor from the Mayor.

5. All Ordinance' or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

6. This Ordinance ~~will~~ <sup>shall</sup> be in full force and effect from and ~~x~~ after its passage and publication as provided by law.

Councilman Ecklund offered Ordinance No. 56. being an Ordinance fixing the compensation of certain officers of the Town of Conrad, Iowa, and same was read the first time.

Councilman J.R.Gier moved that the rule requiring said ordinance to be read on three different days be dispensed with and suspended and that said Ordinance No.56, be passed to its third reading. Motion was seconded by Councilman Sherbon. The motion was put to a vote and declared carried unanimously.

Ordinance was then given its third reading. Councilman Gier then <sup>MOVED</sup> that Ordinance No.56, be adopted. Motion was second by Councilman Sherbon. The Ordinance No.56. was declared adopted, and is as follows:-

Ordinance No. 56.

An Ordinance fixing the Compensation of certain officers of the Town of Conrad, Iowa.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the Town of Conrad, Iowa.

Section. 1. That the salary of the Mayor be \$50.00 per annum which sum shall be in full for all services performed by him except while acting as a Magistrate. While performing the duties of a Magistrate he shall receive the same fees as are allowed by law to Justices of the Peace for similar services to be paid in the same manner.

Section 2. Each Councilman shall receive the sum of \$1.00 for each and every general and special meeting of the Council at which he shall be present, including sessions of not less than three hours of said Council acting as a Board of Review, which shall be in full compensation for all services of such Councilman of every character connected with their official duties; Provided, however, that no Councilman shall receive in the aggregate more than \$50.00 in any one year.

Section 3. The Clerk shall receive as full compensation for all services performed by him as such officer the sum of \$2.00 for each general and special meeting of the Council at which he shall be present including sessions of not less than three hours of said Council acting as a Board of Review, and in addition thereto the sum of ten cents for each hundred words for all records and documents recorded by him when required by law or Ordinance, <sup>to be recorded</sup> and the sum of five cents for each voucher drawn.

Section 4. All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
