COUNCILMAN MCLEAN INTRODUCED THE RESOLUTION ENTITLED A "RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF \$275,000 HEALTH CARE FACILITY REVENUE BONDS", FOR OAKVIEW NURSING HOME, INC., AND MOVED THAT IT BE ADOPTED. MAYOR SCHLEISMAN DECLARED THIS RESOLUTION DULY PASSED AND ADOPTED THIS 11TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1978.

Motion by Zern, second by McLean, to approve a Class C Beer Permit for Charlies Market, Inc. Carried. Motion by Moler, second by Zern, to approve a Sunday Sales Permit for Charlies Market, Inc. Carried.

The special Sanitation Committee involved with acquiring land for a new sewer system, along with Dave Fox and Les Wolfe, reported that a tentative site had been located and photographed and the landowner contacted. It was decided that the landowner should again be contacted with the intention that if he would agree to sell the property a price proposal should be established. This would give the council a better idea of what steps to take next.

Kruse asked the council and Att'y Kliebenstein what procedures he should take in regard to towing cars, their storage, and collection of fees. A few legal points were discussed strengthening the council's decision to continue its present method of removing vehicles during snowfalls. The clerk was directed to re-publish the snow ordinances in a more prominent place in the Conrad Record.

John Nutter, representing PAMCO of Marshalltown, presented the council with several ideas about street cleaning for next year. He stated that he has some cleaning units for sale and also that he was in a position to due contract work for the city. The council is going to investigate this further with other customers of PAMCO before making a decision.

Don Martin and Darrel Schiebel presented the council with a petition signed by 14 members of their neighborhood concerning dog barking. The people who the petition was directed towards were also present. After a discussion by all concerned it was decided that the dogs would be removed from the city. Martin volunteered help in finding a new home for them.

Motion by Beeghly that the Northeast Council On Alcoholism (NECA) for Grundy county again be granted \$700 in a two-part payment. The first in July 1979; the second in December 1979. Second by Moler. Carried.

It was established that approximately \$7500 would be received by the city in Federal Revenue Sharing funds for FY-80. It was decided the following funds would be getting the FRS money: Parks & Recreation - \$2000; Public Safety/Fire - \$3000; Public Safety/Police - \$2500.
